

**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

HERTFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

**Hertfordshire County Council
(Sandridge Footpath 26)
Diversion Order 2024**

This Order is made by Hertfordshire County Council (“the authority”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

A A Sherriff & Son has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

St Albans City and District Council has been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Sandridge and shown by a bold continuous line on the plan contained in this Order (“the Order Plan”) and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
3. There shall on the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Sandridge described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the Order Plan.
4. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.



SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

The full width of that part of Sandridge Footpath 26 running from TL 1804 0973 (Point A on the Order Plan) generally south west through Nashes Farm for approximately 290 metres to a junction with House Lane (Public Highway) at TL 1782 0956 (Point B on the Order Plan).

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A footpath commencing from Sandridge Footpath 26 at TL 1804 0973 (Point A on the Order Plan) running generally west north west for approximately 100 metres to TL 1794 0975 (Point C on the Order Plan) then generally south west, on the north west side of the bund, for approximately 100 metres to TL 1785 0969 (Point D on the Order Plan) and continuing generally south south west for approximately 135 metres to a junction with House Lane (Public Highway) at TL 1782 0956 (Point E on the Order Plan).

Width: 4 metres
