Harness Way Open Space

The two new inground trampolines have been installed, along with the wetpour surfacing around the entrance gate (the latter paid from the 2024/25 budget).

5. Love Where you Live – 2 Minute Litter Pick

In Verulamium Park, the below facility is available to enable users of the park (who want to) to do litter picking. The unit holds a single litterpicker and bags. The Committee is asked to consider whether it would like to introduce something similar at one or more of the parish playgrounds.



6. Installation of a rugby / football combination goal set for Jersey Farm Open Space

At a previous meeting, the Committee discussed a desire to explore the option of adding football goals to Jersey Farm Open Space, as there are often games going on but with players using the rugby goals as makeshift football goals. The Committee also recognised that some residents enjoy the opportunity to play rugby and hat it would be a pity to sacrifice one for the other, should we replace the rugby posts with football goals. The PACE officer has been looking at combination goals (below).



This would enable both football to be played and rugby kicks to be practised (the rugby posts are mostly used for kicking practise as opposed to try scoring). The cost for purchase and installation would be £6,500. Should the Committee wish to proceed, the PACE officer will investigate if we can donate (or sell) the current rugby goals. It is therefore:

Recommended;

To proceed with the purchase and installation of two rugby football goals at Jersey Farm Open Space, replacing the current rugby only posts.

The painting of the ramp is now complete. Mandy Johnson led two successful community painting days in July and completed the remainder herself over the following days. She had a good turnout of budding young artists and received encouraging and positive feedback from residents nearby.

10. 2026/27 Budget

The Committee is asked to reflect on the feedback from the Wheatfields Council Questionnaires (as circulated by Cllr Lambert) and the Facebook feedback discussed at the previous meeting regarding the facilities in the parish and agree on a sum to request from the Finance Committee on the 27th October. Members may wish to consider the option of spending a % of the budget requested and adding the remaining figure to ear marked reserves for a larger installation project in the future. Members should also note that there are plans for housing developments in the parish (as yet without planning permission) that would result in Section 106 funding which could be requested for spend within this committee.

11. Matters of Note

- Basketball nets have been installed on the hoops in Sherwood Park, both in the Multi-Use Games are and the freestanding post.
- The swing set in Harness Way Open Space has been sanded down and painted.
- Wetpour repairs and fencing repairs have been carried out in the toddler playground at Harness Way Open Space.
- The dilapidated bin in Sherwood Park has now been removed.
- The wildflower beds in the open spaces are due to be strimmed and arisings removed ahead of next years seed sowing.
- Two trees (one dead and one dying) were removed from beside the playground at Harness Way Open Space. It is hoped that this will reduce some of the debris falling into the toddler playground.
